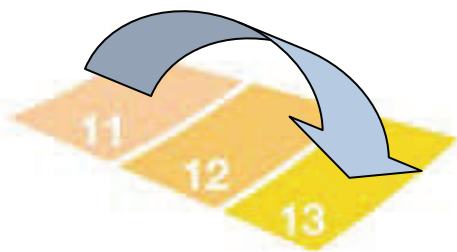
- Rail Ticket presented to connect with a train at Pewsey Station £1 (adult single).

Following the consultation exercises that were carried out last year, Wiltshire Council has been working with the Devizes and Pewsey Community Area Partnerships and the Devizes Passengers Transport Group, to devise a new timetable for the Connect 2 Wiltshire services in the Pewsey Vale that can be operated in a more cost effective manner, whilst still catering for the needs of the majority of its customers.

These new timetables will be introduced on the 1st February 2016.

This service is partly "hail and ride" with fixed stops and times and partly a bookable "wigglybus". The drivers will be happy to help you navigate how this service operates.

**So please read the timetable carefully and book your seat in advance where # is shown as the bus "Calls at this point if required to pick up or set down pre-booked passengers." Please ring 08456 525255 and select option 1 to book a seat.**

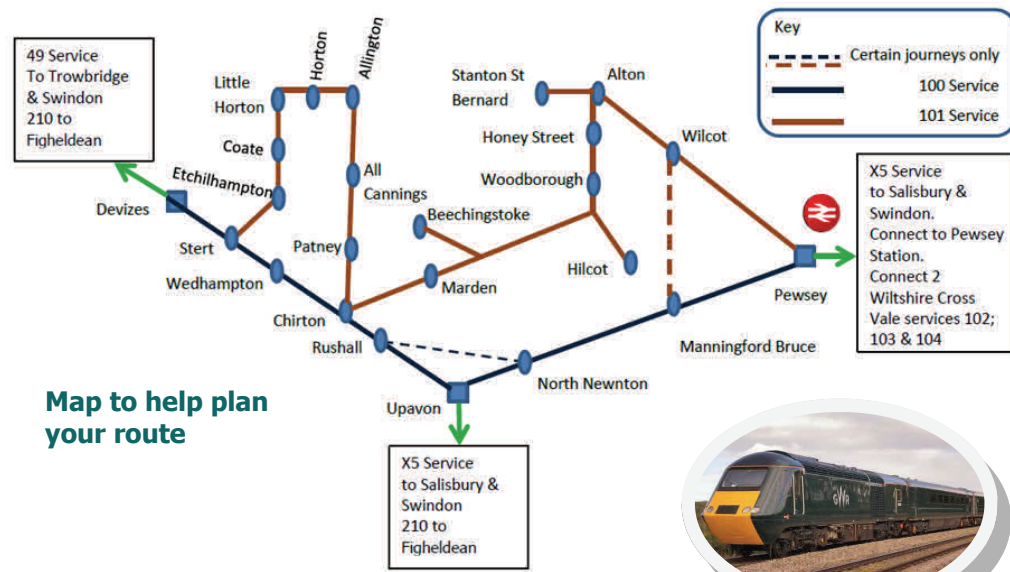

**Onward Journeys**

The 100 and 101 service connects with the following trains at Pewsey Station: Eastbound - 0719; 0809; 1018; 1343; 1626; 1929 and 2122. Westbound - 0808; 1243; 1603; 1744; 1841; 1947; 2048 and 2138

On Saturdays: Eastbound - 0813 ; 1016 ; 1308 ; 1634 ; 1845 and 2108. Westbound - 0943; 1202; 1403; 1603; 1803; 2007 and 2107

There are also onward connections with other bus services: X5; 49 and 210. For the Connect 2 Wiltshire services 102; 103 & 104 see the Cross Vale and Village timetable.

**Travel by zone**
